Sub: - Regarding issue of CUG connections to Health Service Providers

Madam/Sir,

This is to inform you that NRHM is providing Closed User Group (CUG) mobile connections to designated health service providers from sub center level to district and state level authorities H & FW Department under its Mission Connect scheme. The scheme has already covered about 13,100 health service providers in Odisha and aims at covering another 4000 connections in this financial year.

Under the scheme, there are two different plans (Plan-225 and Plan-525) of BSNL have been taken for different categories of health personnel. Annexure-I shows the designations and their entitlements. The existing CUG numbers are uploaded on NRHM web site and can be accessed at www.nrhmorissa.gov.in/cug.

Further, for smooth implementation of the scheme in your district, the guiding points mentioned in Annexure-II must be followed scrupulously.

You may also submit your requisition for any further requirement of SIM cards at your level to the undersigned at the earliest.

Guiding points to issue and manage CUG SIM cards

1. The SIM card is to be handed over to a health service provider after taking the undertaking form.
2. One employee is entitled to get only one CUG number at a time, irrespective of the no. of posts he/she is in charge.
3. If a CUG is allotted to a person and due to surrender/vacancy/ transfer/ resignation/termination has not been utilized for more than 7 (seven) days, it must be reported to mission directorate for immediate deactivation. The same can be activated after re-allotment and report to mission directorate.
4. The concern authority should take necessary step to recover three (3) times of the amount of billing of the period, in case a person did not surrender his/her CUG SIM after his transfer/ resignation/ retirement or termination from the post in due time.
5. The Last Pay Certificate (LPC) of an employee, who has been transferred / resigned/terminated, should not be released in the case of non-submission of CUG SIM card to the concerned authority.
6. If an employee goes on promotion or transferred within the same district, he/she may retain the SIM card only with approval of CDMO of the concerned district. The same must be reported to mission directorate for change of billing address.
7. Any Employee, other than the posts mentioned in Annexure-I, is not entitled to get CUG Connection. If any new designation is required to be added, the prior approval of MD, NRHM is essential.
8. As per the TRAI guideline, a mobile number is non-transferable under any circumstances. However, in case of transfer of an employee and handing over the SIM card to any other employee, the details of change of Name and Address must be intimated to mission directorate for change in billing address immediately.
